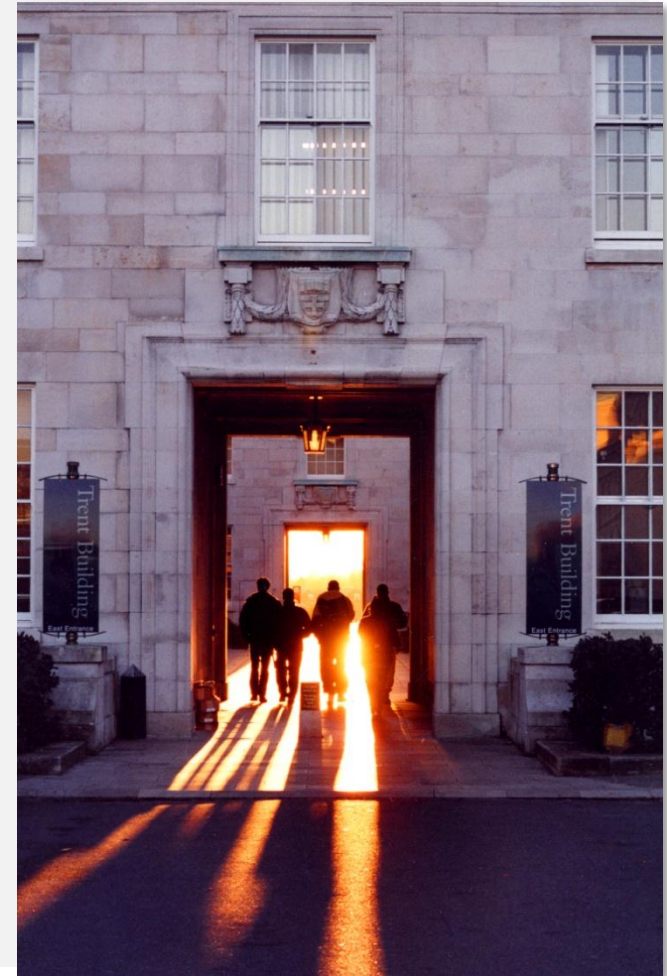

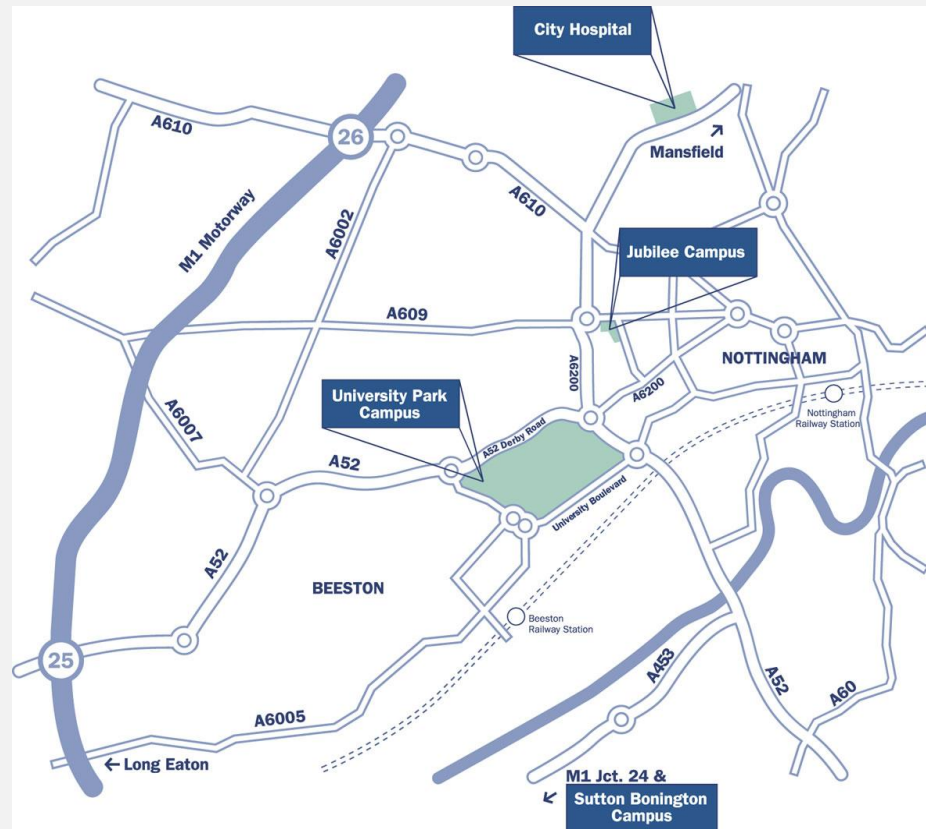
Studying at Nottingham

- Flexible study periods: Autumn Semester (Sept-Jan), Spring Semester (Jan-June), Full Year (Sept-June) or Split Year (Jan-Jan)
