Why an internship?

Funding:

- The WLIP provides financial support through stipends which range from \$10,000 to \$15,000.

Internships are typically for 8 to 12 weeks from May to July.

The Call for Applications is released in December and the deadline is in January.



Exchange Program

Western Law has established exchange partnerships with 20 leading law schools around the world.
