Computers in the Library

If you do not have a laptop computer with you, the law library has 6 public computers on the main floor of the library along with public printers.

Sign on to the computers with your Western Identity username and password.

Printing, Copying, and Scanning

The Law Library has two multi-functional machines for printing, scanning, and photocopying. All students at Western have access to a PaperCut account, which is used to pay for your printing and copying. Scanning is free.

<u>Login to PaperCut</u> with your Western Identity username and password. Once logged in you can add funds to your account by credit card, or you can pay with cash at the Law Library Info Desk.

Print both colour and black & white documents from your personal device, a library computer, with a USB flash drive, and more. Learn more about printing

To pick up prints, tap your Western ONEcard over the tap device on the printer. Your PaperCut account is linked to your Western ONECard. Print instructions differ based on the device you're printing from, more printing information is available on the Western Libraries Website.
